The National Catholic Education Association (NCEA) Catholic Schools Week (CSW) theme is "Catholic Schools: United in Faith and Community." Catholic Schools Week serves as a national platform to celebrate and highlight the unique value of Catholic education in the United States, showcasing the positive impact it has on students' faith development, academic achievement, and community involvement, while also promoting the benefits of a Catholic school education to potential families and the wider community. Each day, Catholic school teachers and staff members challenge students to engage in innovation learning, to problem-solve, to work in teams, and to stretch their thinking. Our teachers show students how to live a faith that is infused throughout their day and help students create an environment that demonstrates concern for others and for God's creation.





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CSW Highlights and Goals:

Focus on faith and values: The week emphasizes the integration of Catholic teachings and values into the curriculum, allowing students to deepen their understanding of their faith through academics and daily life experiences.

Community building: It's an opportunity for students, teachers, staff, families, and parish members to come together and celebrate their shared Catholic identity.

Service and outreach: Many Catholic Schools Week activities involve service projects, demonstrating the importance of giving back to the community.
